As the only doctor of dental surgery program and one of three dental hygiene programs in Oklahoma, the University of Oklahoma College of Dentistry is on the forefront of training our students to become dental professionals. Upon graduation, a state license is required which requires attending an accredited dental program and pass examinations administered by a state governing body for the dental profession.

The College also offers five postdoctoral programs; Advanced Education in General Dentistry, General Practice Residency (housed in the University of Oklahoma Children's Hospital), Graduate Orthodontics, Graduate Periodontics and the Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery Residency.
