Eligibility

*Note: TBSN and ABSN applicants are not required to have an active LPN or RN license, nor do they need a minimum of 1 year of work experience as an LPN or RN.

- · Licensure: Must hold an active LPN or RN license. *
- · Work Experience : Minimum of 1 year of experience as an LPN or RN.*
- Employment at OU Health : A minimum of 6 months of continuous full-time or part-time (.6 FTE or more) employment at OU Health is required.
- Program Admission : Must apply and be admitted to one of the College of Nursing programs and be accepted into the Degree Accelerator Program by OU Health after admission.
- Program Continuation : To remain eligible for the Degree Accelerator Program, students must maintain employment at OU Health throughout the program.
